HOW MUCH PENSION WILL YOU RECEIVE?

Thanks to your employer, you benefit from group insurance through which you build up a supplementary pension in addition to your statutory pension. To do this, your employer chose Vivium, a reliable insurance partner. Together, we will provide you with expert advice in pension matters.

All of your employment details are incorporated into an 'individual statement' on mypension.be, giving you an overview of your individual situation regarding your statutory and supplementary pensions.

You can view the **information about and amount of your supplementary pension(s)**:

- by **professional status** ▶ employed, self-employed, civil servant
- by **pension institution** ▶ P&V Verzekeringen CVBA is referred to as the pension institution for your group insurance with Vivium
- by **contract type** ▶ group insurance, sector plan, etc.

You can also consult your **pension information throughout employment**, see **when** you can claim your statutory pension and calculate, at a later stage, the **amount of your statutory pension** based on said pension information.

 Why is your Vivium group insurance listed under the name P&V?

- ▶ Vivium is a brand name of P&V Verzekeringen CVBA and is part of the P&V Group, a Belgian insurance group founded in 1907. P&V Verzekeringen CVBA acts as the risk bearer.

 On mypension.be, the information concerning your supplementary pension, just like your statutory pension, will always be shown for 1 January of each year.

- ▶ This is why Vivium supplements your annual benefit statement with an appendix (pension slip 01/01) on which you also find this same information on 1 January. You receive this document through your employer.
